


MicroWedge Pole Adapter 12/15 Instructions

The EAW **MicroWedge Pole Adapter** allows the EAW MicroWedge 12 and EAW MicroWedge 15 to be supported by a 1-3/8" diameter pole or tripod stand.

Installation

- The **MicroWedge Pole Adapter** incorporates a reversible plate that allows either an EAW MicroWedge 12 or EAW MicroWedge 15 to be supported.

- To support a MicroWedge 12, attach the reversible plate such that the narrow side is upwards when mounted on the tripod and "MW 12" reads right side up. See Fig 1.

- To support a MicroWedge 15, attach the reversible plate such that the wide side is upwards when mounted on the tripod and "MW 15" reads right side up. See Fig 2.

- With the MicroWedge on the ground and the port facing upwards, loosen the thumb screws enough to slide the **MicroWedge Pole Adapter** into the port with the thumb screws outside the port. See Fig. 3.

- Tighten the two thumb screws by hand so the MicroWedge Pole Adapter is held firmly in place.

- NEVER attempt to lift a MicroWedge by the MicroWedge Pole Adapter.

- Be sure that the tripod stand or pole is rated to support a minimum of 70 pounds for a MicroWedge 12 and a minimum of 90 pounds for a MicroWedge 15.

- Two people gently lift the MicroWedge with the **MicroWedge Pole Adapter** attached over the 1-3/8" tripod stand pole or MicroSub pole and assure that the pole slides all the way up into the **MicroWedge Pole Adapter**.

<u>Removal</u>

- Two people gently lift the MicroWedge and **MicroWedge Pole Adapter** upward and off of the tripod stand or MicroSub pole.

- Set the MicroWedge on the ground with the port facing upwards and loosen the two thumb screws.

- Slide the MicroWedge Pole Adapter off of the MicroWedge.
- Re-tighten the two thumb screws so you don't loose them.
